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**1** Antioch Park

6501 Antioch Road

Two beautiful lakes, paved walking trails, a playground, picnic areas, sightings of wildlife, and plenty of natural beauty.

2 Brown Memorial Park

5040 Booker Drive

Brown Park offers a playground, a covered shelter, a grill and picnic tables, and pickleball and basketball courts.

3 Campbell Park 9674 W. 61st St.

Campbell Park includes bike paths, benches, grills, a playground, picnic areas, and access to the Turkey Creek Streamway Trail.

Chatlain Park
6300 Carter Ave.

Chatlain Park has a "We-Go Swing," the first-ever all-inclusive swing which allows people in wheelchairs to remain in their chair while swinging with their friends across from them.

Merriam Historic Plaza 6304 E. Frontage Road

Stroll a paved walking path with historic signage stations, a beautiful water feature, and the sculpture "Motherhood" by artist Kwan Wu.

6 Merriam Marketplace 5740 Merriam Drive

Home to the Merriam Farmers' Market as well as Flags 4 Freedom, Turkey Creek Car & Motorcycle Show, Merriam Drive Live, and more special events.

Quail Creek Park 7025 Grandview Ave.

Quail Creek boasts a walking path, picnic tables, and playground equipment for the kids.

Turkey Creek Streamway Trail

75th Street to Antioch Road

The trail route follows the path of Turkey Creek and passes through wooded areas, a butterfly garden, and several parks.

8 Waterfall Park

Enjoy a beautiful flowing waterfall along the trail, a grill and picnic area, a playground, two soccer fields, and a public art piece called "Hmmm..."
